Are you a recent university graduate looking for an exciting challenge in the conservation sector as a storyteller? Or are you already working in journalism and you want to apply your skills to the nature and climate-saving sector?

We are looking for a talented and independent thinker who likes to investigate and unearth topics related to our member organisations’ work, namely the restoration and conservation of nature. Understanding campaigning as an essential aspect of messaging facts to policymakers and the broader public is equally important to us, as is the virtuous use of social and mainstream media.

We also believe that video and photos play a substantial role in successful communications. Thus, knowledge of video production and photography is beneficial.

One essential task of the job will be to support a campaign focused on Germany; hence, fluency in German in addition to English proficiency at C1-C2 level is crucial.

We are offering a half-time post (20 hrs per week) for a year, with flexible working periods to allow for side projects. Depending on funds this position may be extended. Following the outbreak of the worldwide Covid-19 pandemic, Eurosite does no longer have its own office and staff are mostly working from home.

The Journalist post has been graded at salary scale 8 (Dutch *CAO Rijk 2021 salarisschalen*, July 2021).
