Please read these terms and conditions before registering for the Natural Climate Buffer study tour.

Registration deadline: 21 March 2018.

Article 1 – Registration fee

The registration fee is a fee to cover costs. The fee is €75,- for non Eurosite members. **Eurosite members and friends of Eurosite receive a 20% discount**, resulting in a registration fee of €60,-.

The fee covers transport, accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner during the study tour.

The fee does not cover travel and accommodation from and to the study tour. Participants are responsible for their own accommodation on the night of Tuesday 17 April 2018.

Should the event be unexpectedly canceled, the organisers are not responsible for incurred travel costs.

Article 2 – General conditions and payment

Participants can register their attendance by completing the online registration form on the Eurosite website. After the submission of the registration form, you will receive a confirmation of your registration. Eurosite will issue an invoice by email. Please note that your participation in the Natural Climate Buffers study tour can only be guaranteed upon full payment of the appropriate registration fee by 10 April 2018.
