



Terms and Conditions (version October 2024)

General Terms and Conditions

1. Eurosite's individual membership fee is determined by the country of residence of the applicant. The fees are published on our website: <https://www.eurosite.org/join/>.
2. Your membership commences on the date on which your membership fee has been received on Eurosite's bank account.
3. If you join in the first half of the year (1 January - 30 June) you must pay the full membership fee applicable to your country of residence, if you join in the second half of the year (1 July - 31 December) you must pay half of the full membership fee applicable to your country of residence.
4. Membership fees should be paid to Eurosite by bank transfer. Please clearly state your full name and the reference 'Eurosite Individual Membership'.

Eurosite is registered in the Business Register of the Dutch Chamber of Commerce (Kamer van Koophandel) with registration number 18090918. Eurosite is a VAT-registered business under the Dutch Small Business Scheme (KOR) with VAT number NL8185.85.948.B01 and is therefore exempt from VAT.

5. Following the submission of your application form and the receipt of your payment, you will receive a confirmation of your membership from the Eurosite Secretariat, along with an invoice for your administration.
6. Your contact details (email address and telephone number) will be added to the Eurosite database. From that moment:
 - You will receive member emails, including the Eurosite eNewsletter and notifications about workshops, publications and consultations, and other important notifications.
 - Your contact details could be shared with other Eurosite members for networking purposes.
 - Unless you object in writing, your name will be listed on the Eurosite website <https://www.eurosite.org/network/#members>. Only if you have given your consent will your contact details be shared on your member profile on the Eurosite website.

10. Should you wish to discontinue your Eurosite membership, you should let us know in writing at the latest one month prior to the end of your membership period, i.e. by 30 November.
